


In 1957 he returned to Stanford Law School, graduated in 1959 with a J.D. and was awarded the "Order of the Coif" an honor given to the top 10% of the class.

He then moved to Merced and worked in the District Attorney's office before joining the law firm of Linneman, Burgess, Telles and Van Atta, a firm started by his father. He also served a year as the Public Defender. After many years of law practice he retired at age 80.

A great joy of his life was skiing in deep powder and he enjoyed many ski trips with Carol, family, and longtime friends to the mountains of Alta, Utah, British Columbia, the Sierras, and Colorado. He also enjoyed walking and hiking trips and he and Carol did so in many areas of the world. He was an avid reader and also enjoyed listening to or watching Teaching Company Great Courses.

A private Celebration of Life will be held at a later date. People wishing, may make a charitable donation of their choice or to any animal or wildlife protective charity.






